

## November 2017 Council Meeting Summary

Dear Members of the ISL community,

We are pleased to provide you with a summary of the Council meeting held at the end of November. The Council wants you to be informed about their work and welcomes your input.

The following was discussed at the Council meeting:

- The Council approved the Policy section of ISL Policy Manual, dealing with school Finance. This leaves only one policy section left for the Council to approve, which is expected in February.
- The Council approved the staffing plan for 2018-19, with the addition of four additional teachers to accommodate expected growth.
- The Council also approved a 2.5% increase in staff salaries in 2018-19 and did not change approved 2% increase in tuition rates. As you are aware, the school is completing a major building project and the increase in tuition will allow us to continue to improve and expand our programs. The new tuition rates are shown below the meeting summary for your planning purposes.
- The Council reviewed survey results from the Endicott Survey for accreditation. They asked the Governance Committee to pay special attention to those items related to the work of the Council and to make proposals on how the Council can address the survey results to enhance their work.
- The Council reviewed the October financial management report and is satisfied with the financial situation of the school.
- The Buildings and Grounds committee reported on key developments in the new construction project.
- The following chart details the tuition rates for 2018-19.

Preschool 3/4	7 265 €
Ktg-Grade 5	13 395 €
Grade 6-10	15 270 €
Grade 11-12	15 865 €

*\* Annual Fee - an annual total fee for tuition for a student enrolled in school.*
