The Elementary School Principal is the educational and operational leader for ISL's Elementary School (PreK2–Grade 5). The Principal provides direction for the strategic development and day-to-day operations of the Elementary School, ensuring academic excellence, student well-being, and a positive, inclusive culture.









The Principal reports to the Director and works closely with the PYP Coordinator, Secondary School Principal, the Teaching & Learning Coordinator, and other members of the Leadership Team.

STRATEGIC & CULTURAL LEADERSHIP

- Set the tone and spirit of ISL through the Elementary School, modeling the mission, vision, and values.
- Serve as a member of the Leadership Team; align Elementary goals with the ISL Strategic Plan.
- Lead an inclusive, high-expectations culture that celebrates diversity, student voice, and wellbeing.

SAFEGUARDING & OPERATIONS

- Ensure the safety and well-being of students and staff; uphold safeguarding and child protection policies and training in line with schoolwide practices.
- Conduct and monitor day-to-day operations of the Elementary School.
- Develop and oversee the Elementary School budget, in coordination with the Director and Senior Leadership Team.
- Ensure compliance with ISL policies and Latvian government regulations.

TEACHING, LEARNING & PYP LEADERSHIP

- Lead, in coordination with the PYP Coordinator, the IB PYP, curriculum design and review, assessment, reporting, professional learning, and resourcing.
- Define, monitor, and elevate high-quality learning; coach, appraise, and supervise teaching in line with schoolwide designs and leadership strategy.
- Oversee inclusion, EAL, and student support services; ensure datainformed differentiation and progress monitoring.
- Approve field trips, absences, and professional learning for staff.
